

Lennon All Weather Clothes Lines – Care Instructions

Installation of your line

While our lines are fitted with wheels for ease of movement **we recommend that the four legs of your line should be placed on a hard surface such as concrete and bolted down securely to ensure stability in high winds / stormy weather conditions. 10mm Bolts are provided.**

Our delivery team will be happy to bolt down your line on request.

If you prefer your line to have the wheels attached we recommend you take measures to weigh down/secure your line to avoid it taking flight in high winds / stormy weather conditions.

Lennon Lines are not responsible for any damage to your line or property after delivery / installation.

Hanging Clothes

To make the best use of space and to aid the drying process we recommend you hang larger/long items on the middle two clothesline cords inside the clothesline. Smaller/shorter items of clothing should be hung on the outer clothesline cords. There is hanging space to the rear of the clothesline best suited to small garments such as shorts / socks etc...

Corner table is provided for you to rest pegs/basket.

Clothesline Maintenance

We recommend washing the louvers on your clothesline periodically throughout the year with a cleaning product such as 'Cif' cream cleaner and rinsing thoroughly with water.

The materials we use in the making of our clotheslines are durable and robust however from time to time you may need to replace your clothesline cord and replacement cord is available to purchase on our website www.lennonlines.ie
